

## New York Kayak Polo

New York Kayak Polo is a 501(c)3 nonprofit club devoted to developing and promoting the sport of Kayak Polo in the New York City area.

Kayak Polo (or Canoe Polo) is a team sport, played with five players per team in specially designed kayaks on calm water. Teams win by scoring goals, putting a water polo ball into a 1.5 x 1 meter goal, which is suspended 2 meters above the water. It is a fast and active team sport, and a great way to improve boat-handling skills and rolling.

The winter season, which will last until late April 2006, takes place on Sunday mornings in a heated indoor pool in Jersey City, NJ.

The summer season will start in May at Pier 63 on the Hudson River, in the embayment just north of Chelsea Piers in Manhattan.

Various regional and national tournaments are planned for this year, including an East Coast Regional tournament at the ACA camp at Lake Sebago in August 2006, hosted by NYKP.
